

The 10 Gigabit BASE-LR LITE SFP+ module transmits at 10 G bps over single mode fiber (SMF) for up to 2 Km.





- 3. Connect a single-mode LC to LC duplex cable to the module.




Remove the Module

You do not need to power off the switch before removing the module.

> To remove a module:

- 1. Disconnect any cables from the module.
- 2. Pull down on the module latch.
- 3. Pull the module out of the module slot.
